Israel: Freedom to Slavery

1800 BC	Israel stays in Egypt, multiplies, is enslaved (Ex. 1)
1525 BC	Moses born & adopted during the time of killing firstborn (Ex. 2)
1486 BC	Moses kills the Egyptian and flees to Midian (Ex. 2)
1446 BC	Moses called to deliver Israel (Ex. 3-4)

	Ten Plagues on Egypt (Ex. 7-12)

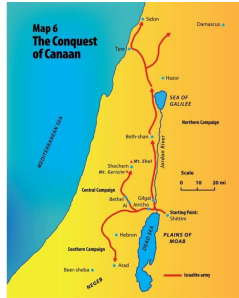

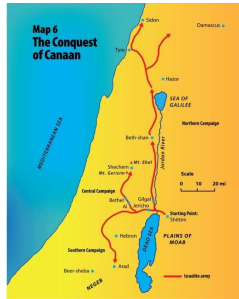
