- David Flees to the Philistines (1 Sam. 27)

- Saul and His Sons Killed (1 Sam. 31; 1 Chr. 10)
- David Mourns Saul & Jonathan (2 Sam. 1)
- David Made King of Judah; Ishbosheth made King of Israel (2 Sam. 2:1-11)

THE KINGDOM DIVIDED AND REUNITED

1008 BC

- Civil War begins between the Houses of Saul (Ishbosheth) and David under Abner and Joab (2 Sam. 2:12)
- David grows stronger (2 Sam. 3)

1005 BC - Abner joins David and is murdered by Joab (2 Sam. 3)

1004 BC - Ishbosheth murdered (2 Sam. 4)

1003 BC - David anointed King of all Israel and conquers Jerusalem (2 Sam. 5; 1 Chr. 11)

1002 BC - David's family and army grow (2 Sam. 5; 1 Chr. 12,14)

DAVID'S REIGN

1000 BC

- David retrieves the Ark; Uzzah dies upon touching it; The Ark is brought to Jerusalem (2 Sam. 6; 1 Chr. 12-15)
- David plans a Temple (2 Sam. 7; 1 Chr. 17)

998 BC

- David defeats the Philistines & Strengthens the Kingdom (2 Sam. 8; 1 Chr. 18)
- David's festival sacrifice (1 Chr. 16)
- Psalms 15, 24, 60, 96, 105, 106

995 BC

- David and Mephibosheth (2 Sam. 9)
- David defeats Ammon and Aram (2 Sam. 10, 1 Chr. 19)

993 BC

- David, Bathsheba, the Prophet Nathan (2 Sam. 11)
- The Capture of Rabbah (2 Sam. 11; 1 Chr. 20)

DAVID'S REIGN

992 BC

- Nathan rebukes David (2 Sam. 12)
- Psalm 51

990 BC - Solomon is born (2 Sam. 12)

987 BC – Amnon and Tamar (2 Sam. 13)

985 BC – Absalom's revenge (2 Sam. 13)

982 BC - The widow of Tekoa (2 Sam. 14)

980 BC - Absalom and David reconciled (2 Sam. 14)

979 BC

- Psalms of David, Korah, Asaph, & other
- David takes a Census (2 Sam. 24; 1 Chr. 21)
- Preparations and ordering of the Temple (1 Chr. 21-26)
- Ordering of the government (1 Chr. 27)

A DIFFICULT TIME

976 BC

- Absalom grows in popularity and conspires against David, who flees Jerusalem (2 Sam. 15)
- On the road, David encounters Ziba and Shimei (2 Sam. 16)
- Hushai spies for David (2 Sam. 17)
- Absalom attacks and is slain by Joab; David mourns Absalom (2 Sam. 18)
- Joab reproves David; David restored but tensions rise (2 Sam. 19)

976 BC

- Sheba's rebellion (2 Sam. 20)
- Psalms 41, 55, 63

974 BC

- The Gibeonites avenged (2 Sam. 21)
- Songs (2 Sam. 22-23)
- Psalm 108

DAVID TO SOLOMON

972 BC

- David Commissions Solomon and gives plans for the Temple (1 Chr. 28)
- Adonijah usurps the kingdom (1 Kgs. 1)
- Solomon anointed King (1 Kgs. 1, 1 Chr. 29)

970 BC

- David dies (1 Kgs. 2; 1 Chr. 29)
- Execution of Adonijah, Joab, and Shimei (1 Kgs. 2)

967 BC

- Solomon asks for wisdom and is granted it (1 Kgs. 3-4, 2 Chr. 1)
- Temple Preparations (1 Kgs. 5, 2 Chr. 2)
- Psalm 72

966 BC

- Building the Temple (1 Kgs. 6-7, 2 Chr. 3-4)
- Building of the Palace (1 Kgs. 7)

THE REIGN OF SOLOMON

959 BC

- The Ark brought into the Temple and Solomon's prayers and sacrifices (1 Kgs. 8, 2 Chr. 5-7)
- God's Presence in the Temple and Covenant with Solomon (1 Kgs. 9, 2 Chr. 7)
- Additional building (1 Kgs 9, 2 Chr. 8)
- Psalms 135, 136
- Solomon prospers

950 BC (+/-)

- Proverbs
- Song of Songs
- Psalm 127

946 BC - The Queen of Sheba (1 Kgs. 10, 2 Chr. 9)

939 BC

- Solomon's wives and Idolatry (1 Kgs. 11)
- God's anger against Solomon (1 Kgs. 11)

THE KINGDOM DIVIDED: JUDAH (SOUTH) AND ISRAEL (NORTH)

937 BC – Ecclesiastes

931 BC

- Jeroboam raised up (1 Kgs. 11)
- Solomon's death (1 Kgs. 11, 2 Chr. 9)

930 BC

- The Kingdom is divided: Rehoboam over Judah & Benjamin and Jeroboam over the 10 tribes of Israel (1 Kgs 12, 2 Chr. 10)
- Jeroboam sins (1 Kgs 12-13)

927 BC - Rehoboam's sin and Judah's submission to Egypt (1 Kgs 14, 2 Chr 12)

913 BC

- Rehoboam dies after a wicked reign (1 Kgs. 14, 2 Chr. 12)
- Abijah reigns as his father did (1 Kgs. 15, 2 Chr. 13)
- War between Judah and Israel (1 Kgs. 15, 2 Chr. 13)

THE KINGDOM DIVIDED: JUDAH (SOUTH) AND ISRAEL (NORTH)

910 BC – Abijah dies and Asa reigns in Judah, doing what is right in the eyes of the Lord (1 Kgs. 15, 2 Chr. 14-15)

909 BC – Nadab succeeds Jeroboam in Israel and does evil (1 Kgs 14)

908 BC

- Baasha succeeds Nadab in Israel and does evil (1 Kgs 14)
- Baasah wars with Asa (1 Kgs 15, 2 Chr. 16)

885 BC – Elah succeeds Baasha in Israel (1 Kgs 16)

884 BC

- Zimri overthrows Elah to reign in Israel for 7 days (1 Kgs 16)
- Omri succeeds Zimri in Israel and is contested by Tibni (1 Kgs 16)

880 BC – Omri is uncontested in reign of Israel, doing evil like his fathers (1 Kgs 16)

THE KINGDOM DIVIDED: JUDAH (SOUTH) AND ISRAEL (NORTH)

874 BC – Ahab succeeds Omri in Israel, doing more evil than those before (1 Kgs 16)

869 BC – Jehoshaphat succeeds Asa in Judah (1 Kgs 15, 2 Chr. 17)
